<b>5. Subject content and associated learning outcomes</b> Occlusal norms and deviations from norms; principles of prophylactic and therapeutic procedures in diseases of the masticatory organ; viral, bacterial and fungal flora of the oral cavity; symptoms, course, management of diseases of the oral cavity, head and neck, pulp and mineralized dental tissues, perioperic diseases; injuries of the teeth and bones of the face; morphology of dental cavities, principles of endodontic treatment; cysts, precancerous conditions, and head and neck cancers; periodontal and oral mucosa diseases; aesthetic dentistry; restorative; stomatognathic system diseases; antibiotic therapy; pain, anxiety and stress; anesthesia; radiological diagnostics; oral diseases and general health; pathomechanism of the impact of general diseases or therapies on the oral cavity; the specificity of dental care for a patient burdened with a general disease and the principles of cooperation with the physician in charge of the underlying disease.
