Subject content and associated learning outcomes</b> Occlusal standards; viral, bacterial and fungal flora of the oral cavity; diagnosis, treatment of acute and chronic, odontogenic and non-odontogenic inflammatory processes in the oral cavity; complications of stomatognathic system diseases; oral diseases and general health; prophylaxis of oral diseases; specificity of dental care for a patient with a general disease; rules of cooperation with the physician in charge of the underlying disease; medical interview with the patient, his family; physical examination; explaining to the patient the essence of his ailments; informed consent of the patient; unfavorable prognosis; additional research; general and local complications during and after dental procedures; patient records; describe dental intra oral pictures and pantomogram scans. <b>Form of approval:</b> EXAM
