Students will learn how to diagnose and treat most common infectious diseases. Students will be able to perform clinical assessment of patients with jaundice, viral hepatitis, neuroinfectious and HIV infection. They will also be trained to procedure with patients with decompensated liver cirrhosis. Some invasive procedures like liver biopsy, lumbar puncture and paracentesis will be presented.
