M: English is spoken on site by all staff, a basic level is sufficient for communication, but to really get something out of this mobility and learn, it is worth speaking fluently, including medical/anatomical language.



General impressions about the Host Institution, the organization of internships, what was the issue of food, did the facility have a canteen?



M: My impression is extremely good, it was even the best practice of my whole course of studies. The working hours are set individually, the organisation of the work consists of accompanying your Practice Supervisor and helping him with his patients, moreover there is always someone else who can use the help and by the way share their knowledge and experience, tell you about the patient etc. Over time there is more and more independence and individual work with the patient. Overall it is an ideal place to prepare for the profession. There is a social room with a fridge, toaster, microwave, coffee machine, water dispenser and a place to eat, but you can't call it a canteen.




Attractions in the area worth seeing?
