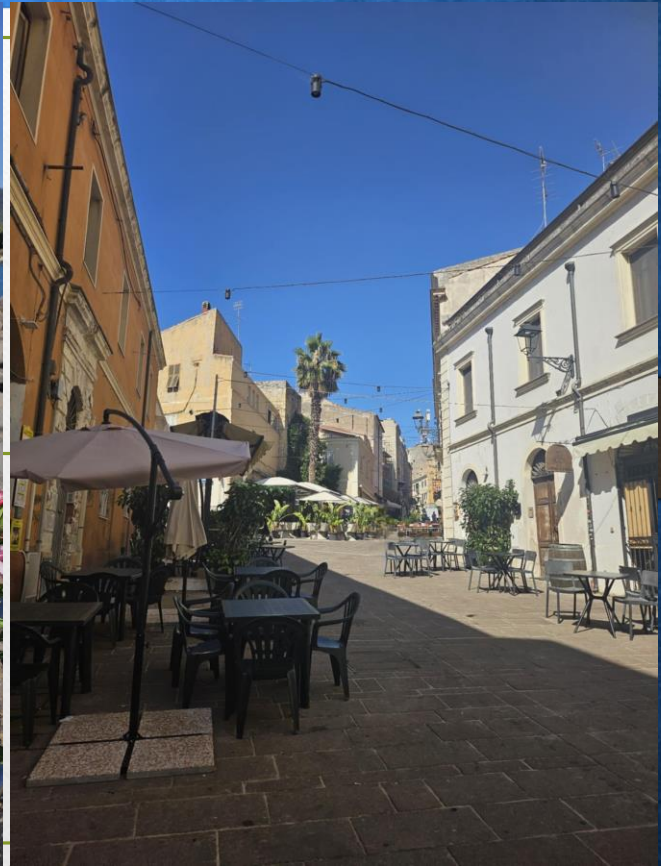

Attractions in the area worth seeing?

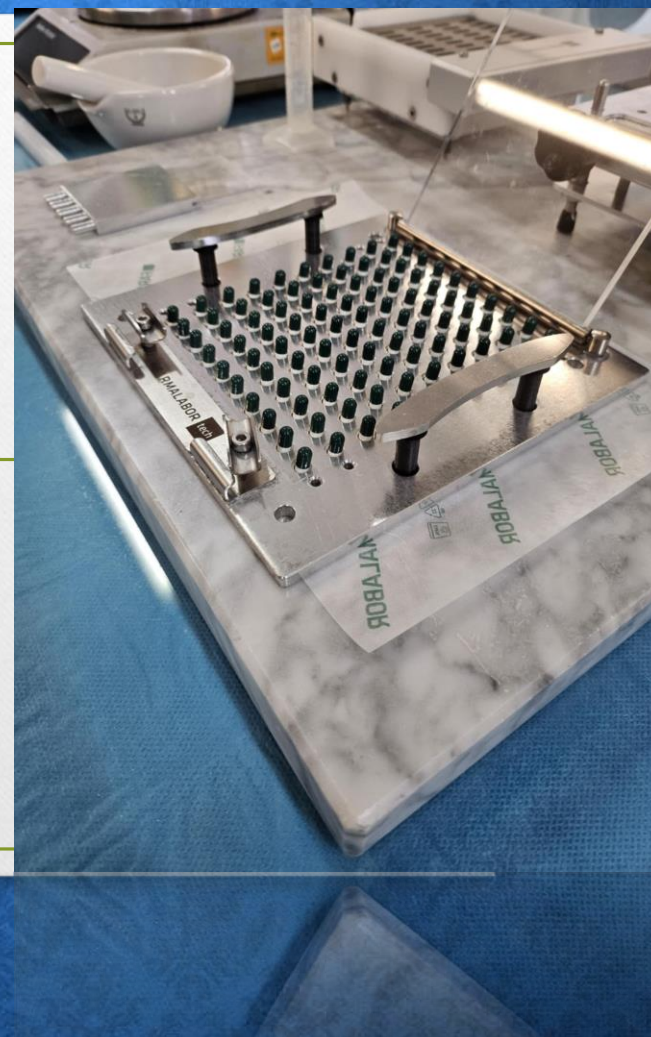
